

# Contract For Livestock Suppliers

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## The SRCHA must be provided with a copy of the Livestock Shipping Manifest

For all purposes in this document Contactor will mean The person or company that supplies cattle for a SRCHA show and Show Host will mean the person or company that Hosts A SRCHA Approved Show.

The Contractor \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ agrees to supply \_\_\_\_\_ head of cattle for the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ per head per day to the Show Host \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_.

Trucking may or may not be included in the above price if it is not included the trucking rate will be \$\_\_\_\_\_ per load. This contract is between the Contractor and the Show Host and in no way does the SRCHA assume any responsibility for this agreement.

The cattle must weigh between 500 and 900 lbs. They must be healthy, sound of wind and limb and must have good vision in both eyes. Cattle that have eyes that have spots, are cloudy or blind may not be used. They may not have horns longer than 2 inches from the base of the horn if they are to be used for Fence Work. Cattle that arrive at show that do not meet these criteria will not be paid for by the host. Fresh cattle are required for each show day.

The Show Host assumes responsibility for the cattle from such a time they are unloaded from the Trailers until such a time as they are loaded back on to the Trailers for transportation home. The Contractor is responsible for transportation insurance and it is recommended that Hartford Insurance is used or that they self insure their cattle for transportation.
