_____ To celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Saskatchewan Reined Cow Horse Association in 2014, as well as to celebrate the quality of the great stallions and their offspring in and around Saskatchewan, the SRCHA decided to develop their own SRCHA Stallion Incentive Fund to help promote these stallions and their offspring to more cow horse owners and events throughout the province each year; at the same time allowing their offspring the opportunity to compete for added prize money and recognition.

Stallions will be nominated by the stallion owners for each foal year. Yearling offspring of these stallions can be nominated for a fee of \$50 per individual before Dec. 31 of their yearling year

Nominated foals will be eligible to compete as 3, 4, and 5yr olds at the SRCHA Stallion Incentive Fund Futurity and Derby to be held in conjunction with SRCHA Classic Cow Horse Futurity and Derby Show held annually. Nomination Fees will be set aside into a fund from which prize money will be drawn for each of the Futurity and Derby classes that the foals from each year of nominated stallions will be eligible for.

Stallion Incentive Classes will include both Open and Non-Pro Futurity (3 yr olds), and Open and Non-Pro Derby (4 and 5 yr olds). These classes will run concurrently with the Classic Open and Non-Pro Futurity and Derby classes making nominated foals eligible for added money for three full years of competition. In addition, in 2016, a Stallion Incentive Fund Bridle class, both Open and Non-Pro (6 yr olds and up) was added, but only as a jackpot class without incentive fund money. This class will however, still giving nominated foals another opportunity to earn even more monies and have recognition as Bridle horses.
